ENROLLMENT

Almost 5,000 students now.....7,000 students expected by 1970.

LOCATION

200 acre campus in East end of Duluth.....overlooks Lake Superior.....3 miles from downtown.

HISTORY

Established as University campus on July 1, 1947.....UMD is one of four campuses of the University of Minnesota.....predecessors, Duluth State Teacher's College and Duluth Normal School date back to turn of century.

PHYSICAL GROWTH

First building on new campus begun 1947.....first classes held on new campus in 1950.....all classes now held on new campus in 14 major buildings valued at \$25 million..... UMD injects \$11 million into area economy each year.

Construction in next two years includes.....400 student dormitory..... performing arts building.....classroom-office building.....administration building.

SPECIAL FACILITIES

Tweed Art Gallery.....Marshall W. Alworth Planetarium..... Darling Observatory.....112,000 volume UMD library.....Bull Pub--student dining-meeting area with 18th century english atmosphere.....UMD Campus Club.....Rock Hill ski area.

FACULTY

Numbers over 250.....almost half have their doctorates.

SUMMER SESSIONS

About 2,500 attend the two summer sessions yearly.....over 100 courses offered per session plus special institutes and workshops.

EXTENSION CLASSES

University General Extension Division offers evening courses at UMD.....night class enrollment exceeds 1,000.

STUDENT ACTIVITIES

8 loan plans and 88 scholarships offered to UMD students..... 80 student organizations.....9 sororities and fraternities.....theater activities,.....intramural sports.....varsity athletics.....publicationsmusic.....debate.....student government.....special interest organizations.

ATHLETICS

Hockey team competes in Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA).....football, basketball, swimming, wrestling, skiing, track, tennis, golf teams compete in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC).
