CALENDAR SUGGESTIONS---Next winter a decision will be made on UMD's calendar year for 1982-84. A subcommittee to the calendar committee is considering calendar choices and would like to have suggestions made to them about alternatives. According to Tom Jordan, physics, there seems to be fairly broad agreement that UMD should not change to anything substantially different from three quarters, each having ten weeks of classes, with not more than nine months from a week before classes start in the fall to the end of final exams in the spring.
